Part A – Application Form

- **Must** be under the age of 19 at the start of school in September of their Graduation year
- **Must** be a Canadian Citizen, Landed immigrant or permanent resident
- **Must** be enrolled in a minimum of 3 post secondary courses
- **Must** be completed in blue or black Ink
- **Must** be legible
- **Must** see school Principal immediately if there is an issue with guardianship

Part B - Verification Signatures

- **Must** be completed in blue or black ink
- **Must** be signed by student
- **Must** be signed by parent/guardian/Principal
- If student is NOT submitting T4 or other financial information please initial in space provided
- See school Principal with any eligibility, financial or guardianship concerns immediately so a resolution can be reached well in advance of the deadline

Financial Documents

If you are applying for any bursaries or awards that state financial need as a requirement, then all sources of income must be declared with taxation proof by way of:

- 2021's T4 and proof of income for ***yourself as well as parents/common-law partners/guardians/other supporting adults***

or,

- 2021 CRA Income Tax returns; pages 2 and 3, showing lines 150-260

and,

- If self employed, the applicable statement of business/professional activities

Please provide **ONE COPY** of the above for **all** parents/common-law partners/guardians/other supporting adults (even if they are living apart) **as well as the student**. If there has been a recent change of employment within your family, please provide a Record of Employment.

Please note that ALL Financial documents are viewed only by Liane Kimmie, Scholarship and Bursary Chair, and are treated with the utmost confidentiality. Income is calculated and given a level on a rubric (see below). Donors and Committee only see the level the student falls under – **no totals are ever given**. If there is an issue with financial documents please contact the school Principal immediately.

Part C – Awards Selection

▣ RESUME

Resume must include:

- Accomplishments from Grade 7 forward
- Service and leadership you have demonstrated in terms of clubs or activities , positions held with that club/activity as well as dates of participation
- Community involvement
- Accomplishments/Certificates
- Work experience
- Volunteer work
- Sports

☑ TRANSCRIPTS

A transcript with current grades will **be provided by the school** for all awards, you do not need to ask for a copy.

☐ TWO REFERENCES

Teacher Reference – Only use the Teacher Reference form provided (see attached). The reference form must be returned in a **sealed envelope** for submission to committee. Teacher must sign sealed flap. DO NOT unseal envelope. Applicants are responsible for requesting, picking up and including Teacher Reference Forms.

Local Community Member – Letter of reference can be emailed but a copy of the original email stating date and time the email was sent MUST be included. Your reference may NOT be a direct relative, an employer, a secondary school counsellor, a secondary school administrator, member of Scholarship and Bursary Committee or a District Administrator. Letter does not need to be in a sealed envelope.

☐ ESSAYS

Essays must be typed with the title of the award and the applicants name at the top of the page. Please do not use staples – make use of headers or footers, if you have more than one page. Do not double side any documents.

☐ SPECIAL APPLICATION FORMS

- Special application forms are available in the Career Centre.
- Forms must be completed in blue or black ink and be legible.

☐ SCHOLARSHIP AND BURSARY APPLICATION FORM

- Application form must be completed in Blue or Black Ink, information must be legible, and the awards that are being applied for must be CLEARLY indicated by a check mark or an X
- Parent/ Guardian and Student must sign application form to be considered for any award
- Please do not staple the application form

☐ WORKPLACE/MEMBERSHIP

Any awards requiring applicants/parents/guardians/relatives etc. to be a member or employee must clearly state who works or is a member of the company, division, union, church, group, etc. on the application form. Attach required proof if required. ***If providing a T4(s) from West Fraser you must indicate on T4 which Division of West Fraser.***

☐ T4'S AND/OR OTHER STATEMENTS FOR BURSARIES

Include T4's from student, parent(s), supporting adults, guardians, common law parents. **See school Principal immediately with any issues regarding financial documents.**

Remember:

- To be eligible, the following pages must be completed in blue or black ink, all writing must be legible and completed in full and all supporting documents for selected awards must be included
- Ms. Ingram and Ms. Kinloch are available during school hours to assist with applications and questions. They will go over the entire package with you.
- If you want your application to be checked thoroughly after completion, you **MUST** present it to Ms. Kinloch or Ms. Ingram before **Friday, April 8, 2022**
- Any issues (financial, guardianship or other) must be presented to your Principal immediately to be resolved
- In order to receive the awarded funds, students must be enrolled in a minimum of three post-secondary level courses. Students must apply for their funds from the Scholarship, Bursary or Award donor **within the first year of studies**. Available time to claim the award is set from September following Graduation. Awards can be claimed sooner upon proof of course registration.
- All Scholarships and Bursaries will be paid to accredited institutions unless otherwise specified
- A follow-up thank you letter is **STRONGLY** recommended
- Recipients will be notified in June
- **DONORS WILL NOT MAKE EXCEPTIONS FOR LATE ENTRIES OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS**
