Ringette was invented in Canada in 1963

First introduced in 1963 in North Bay,
Ontario.

Originally developed for girls, ringette is a
fast-paced team sport on ice in which players
use a straight stick to pass, carry, and shoot a
rubber ring to score goals.

For ten years, play centered in Ontario and
Quebec, however the sport quickly spread
across Canada and is now played in all ten
provinces and the Northwest Territories.

The sport has become one of Canada's
favourite activities for females, with over
50,000 participants, including players,
coaches, officials and volunteers

Throughout the season many tournaments are
held across BC.

Canada has been instrumental in
demonstrating the game in the Netherlands,
Switzerland, West Germany, New Zealand,
Australia and Japan. Associations have
formed in the USA, Finland, Sweden, Russia,
and France.

World Championships are held every three
years.
