

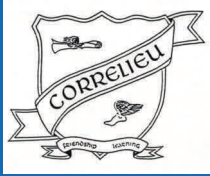

Principal's Message

At Correlieu we are already working on creating a timetable for next year. The timetable process takes a long time. The first step is to allow the students to make their course selections. It is student choice that drives the building of the timetable. For example, if only 25 students want a guitar class, then only one guitar class will be built into the timetable. If 75 students want a guitar class, then three guitar classes will be built into the timetable. This can sometimes get a bit tricky because we know students change their minds after they have made their selections, and sometimes we do not have space in our classes to make the changes they want.

As part of the course selection process we always bring the grade 9 students to Correlieu to tour all of our elective areas. This way they get a sense of what each elective entails and they are better prepared to choose. Grade 9 orientation day will be March 10 and all grade 10 students will not come to school on that day.

Scholarship, Bursary & Awards 2020

It is scholarship, bursary and awards season. The booklet will be released to all grade 12 students. This year we have over \$80,000 in locally donated money to give away to students going to post-secondary. Many people believe that awards go to students with highest marks, this is not true. Most awards are based on other criteria, such as financial need, school and community involvement, citizenship skills and work ethic. All students who plan to go to any post-secondary are encouraged to apply for scholarships, bursaries and awards.
